2024-25 Nature Based Outdoor School at 92nd Street & Lighthouse Parks Tuition and Registration Information for Preschool/PreK/K

At The Learning Connection, every day is an Outdoor Adventure! Explore and learn about flora and fauna in our area. Expect to get dirty! You will adventure through nearby outdoor spaces, learn about different habitats, climb stumps and logs, hike trails, make mud pies, dig in the dirt and sand, examine specimen from the creek and Sound, spot insects and other flying and crawling animals, hug a tree and bask in the sun (and rain). Experience hands-on lessons, learn new skills, stories, activities, science, and free exploration!

The Learning Connection offers a curriculum developed by experienced educators. Our program is designed to provide a variety of learning experiences in a child-centered, nurturing environment. TLC emphasizes creative thinking, higher level thinking skills, educational skill development and imagination. Students will participate in activities that align with Common Core State Standards, Washington Early Learning Benchmarks, Learning Strategies GOLD, and National Standards. Children will explore thematic units through active, hands-on, activities. There is a balance between structure and exploration/choices. Curriculum includes reading, writing, phonics, science, social studies, life skills, mathematical concepts/reasoning, geography, artistic expression, and interactive play. Focus is on each child's social and emotional growth, as well as their physical and mental development. Children grow in their own special way and time.

Admission Procedure: Every new family will schedule a tour/visit to experience our learning environment. Each new student will be interviewed/observed by our staff to determine if TLC is the right placement. All new students will be enrolled on a trial basis of one week. We reserve the right to terminate your child's enrollment at will. Refunds will not be given for the trial week regardless of reason.

Tuition: Tuition is based on the October-June school year and is divided up into 9 equal payments regardless of school days per individual month. **Tuition is not discounted for holidays, breaks, vacations, or other absences.** TLC follows the Mukilteo School District calendar for winter, mid-winter, and spring breaks. Tuition is due on the 20th of every month for the following month. Should the 20th fall on a Saturday or Sunday, it is due on the Friday before. **Tuition will be considered late if it is not received by 12:30pm 2 business days after it is due, at that time a \$50 per day late fee will be added to your account. After three days, your child will not be admitted until ALL outstanding balances are paid in full. In the event your student does not remain enrolled at TLC after their one-week trial period, you will receive a prorated refund for that month's tuition.**

Deposit: Your deposit amount equals one tuition payment and is collected at registration. Deposit will be used for June's tuition. Please see withdrawal policy. Deposits for new students will be held until your trial week is completed.

Registration Fee: The registration process and enrollment forms must be completed annually for all students. The registration fee is non-refundable and is \$150 per family per year. This fee does not apply toward tuition.

Curriculum/Material Fee: This annual fee covers specialists and specialized materials. The \$100 materials fee will be collected with September's tuition.

Sibling Discount: A 5% discount will be applied to the lowest tuition rate. Discounts may not be combined.

Tuition Paid in Full Discount: Receive a 5% discount on tuition with a full check/cash payment and a 2% discount on a credit card payment. May not be combined with any other discounts.

Withdrawal/Reduction of Hours: If you withdraw your child prior to the end of the school year, written notice is required by the 15th of the month two months prior (75 days notice) to the student's last day. Your deposit will be used for your last month's tuition. **Exception:** If you choose to withdraw your child in May, your deposit is forfeit. If 75 days notice is not received, your deposit is forfeit.

Potty Training: Children must be fully potty trained.
